THOUSAND TRAILS / LEISURE TIME PARADISE PRESERVE May 16 – 19, 2013 (Thursday – Sunday)

Location: Thousand Trails Paradise Preserve (Leisure Time) – near Mossyrock 173 Salem Plant Road, Silver Creek WA 98585 (note: there's a typo on the flyer handed out at the meeting – "173" is correct)

Directions: I-5 south to Exit 68 (Morton-Yakima-Hwy 12 East); turn left over freeway and continue east on Hwy 12 approx. 14 miles;

Turn left onto SR-122 at the Silver Creek Grange (an old empty white building on the left which also has an "Antiques" banner-type sign on it, in addition to the "Silver Creek" signage); (grange is at the top of the hill where the truck lane ends – if you proceed past where the truck lane merges back to one lane, you've missed the turn); proceed and turn left on Schoen Road (first road on the left); proceed up the hill 1 mile and at the 90-degree left turn (watch for the arrow sign), go straight ahead on Salem Plant Road. There are Thousand Trails/Encore signs along the way.

Reservations: We have reserved 8 water/electric sites until the day <u>after</u> April's meeting, at which time I must send a complete list of those going and any remaining sites will be released. We can get more sites up until April 24. You will probably be able to get into the park after April 24 but might not be next to our group.

Your family and friends are welcome to join us! Just let us know how many are coming. Park Description: This preserve has over 200 sites, numerous tents sites and rental

cabins and trailers. There's the usual club house, adult lodge, tennis courts, shuffle board, plus, 2 private lakes (one 5 acres in size and the other 10 acres). The park stocks the lakes with trout four times per season and no state license is required. The park does charge \$3 per day per person to fish, with a 3-fish limit per day. There are row boats and kayaks for rent or you can bring your own small boat – no gas motors – electric motors are OK. Just be sure let the ranger know if you bring your boat and motor. The setting for the park is gorgeous – views of mountains, lakes, rolling hills – as you drive in. **EVERETTES RV CLUB - JUNE OUTING 2013**
